CONTEXT

The STREAM project aims to enhance **Work-Based Learning (WBL)** and **international mobility** in Italy, Spain, Ireland, Lithuania, and Greece by developing a structured approach for recognizing the skills of VET (Vocational Education and Training) tutors and company mentors.



PROBLEM

- ! Lack of European standards for recognizing the skills of VET tutors and company mentors.
- ! Undefined roles and responsibilities in mobility and WBL organisation.

SOLUTION: STREAM BLUEPRINT

- ✓ Creation of the Occupational Profile for Transnational Mobility and WBL Organiser.
- ✓ A flexible training structure adaptable to different educational contexts.
- ✓ Integration of digital, green, and inclusive competencies as core elements of WBL programs.



KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OCCUPATIONAL PROFILE

- Program Coordination & Development:** Organising mobility experiences with companies and educational institutions.
- Information & Promotion:** Raising awareness of WBL opportunities.
- Support for Apprentices & Trainees:** Providing guidance during the mobility process.
- Compliance with Standards:** Ensuring alignment with European frameworks and regulations.
- Cross-cultural Facilitation:** Managing cultural adaptation and promoting intercultural communication.
- Stakeholder Engagement:** Collaborating with businesses, institutions, and policymakers.
- Problem-solving & Conflict Resolution:** Addressing mobility and training challenges.
- Assessment & Evaluation:** Monitoring learner progress and measuring impact.

STREAM MICRO CREDENTIAL COMPETENCE FRAMEWORK

Three essential competency clusters:

Green: Implementation of sustainable practices and promotion of ecological transitions.

Digital: Use of innovative digital tools for effective WBL coordination and learner support.

Inclusion: Ensuring accessibility and fostering diversity in WBL programs
